

Hart County Board of Commissioners Called Meeting Tuesday April 5, 2022, at 6:00 PM At the Administrative and Emergency Services Building

Chairman Sayer called the meeting to order. Commissioners present were Commissioner Dorsey, Commissioner Teasley, and Commissioner Bennett.

The agenda was amended to add a property tax refund request for Mr. Gregory Daniel. Commissioner Dorsey made a motion to approve the agenda as amended. Commissioner Teasley provided a second to the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0

1. Mr. Gregory Daniel property tax refund request

County attorney Gordon explained the further research into the Daniel's tax situation and that there was an exception to the April 1, filling deadline for cases of veteran's disability cases. The actual date of disability could be used for the tax exempt status even if the official notification of the classification was past the April 1 deadline for filling. This would make granting Mr. Daniel's request for a refund legal under this clause in the law and not illegal as the previous denial was based on. Commissioner Dorsey made a motion to grant the refund based on the latest information that was discovered and presented to the Board by County Attorney Gordon. Commissioner Teasley provided a second to the motion. The motion passed by a 4-0 vote.

2. Subdivision Ordinance Discussion

The Chairman requested that the County Attorney complete an initial draft of the new subdivision ordinance taken from all discussions and information that has been gathered from discussions concerning the recommendations from the Board from the past meetings and have ready at the next meeting or as soon as reasonable. There were discussions concerning tiny houses, duplexes, and townhouses. No official actions were taken.

3. Executive Session - Personnel

Commissioner Teasley made a motion to enter executive session for personnel. Commissioner Bennett provided a second to the motion. The motion passed by a 4-0 vote.

Commissioner Teasley had a personal matter to arise and left during executive session. Commissioner Bennett made a motion to exit executive session. Commissioner Dorsey provided a second to the motion. The motion passed by a 3-0 vote.

Commissioner Dorsey made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Bennett provided a second to the motion. The motion passed by a 3-0 vote.
