Commissioner Dorsey reported the bridge replacement on Hwy 29 S is scheduled to be complete by August 31, 2023; also voiced concerns for school bus routing due to the bridge detour routes.

12. Old Business

a) Duplex Ordinance Third and Final Reading

Commissioner Bennett moved to approve the third and final reading of the Duplex Ordinance as per the amendments for parking and turning areas. Commissioner Dorsey provided a second to the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

b) Purchase of Leased Ladder Truck Fire Department

Commissioner Dorsey moved to proceed with purchasing a leased ladder truck under emergency situation for \$158,050 from SPLOST funds. Commissioner Teasley provided a second to the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

c) Approval of City of Hartwell SPLOST VI percentages

Commissioner Dorsey moved to approve City of Hartwell's percentage of SPLOST VI funds of 17.3%; Bowersville \$371,200; City of Royston \$716,800; City of Canon \$7,400. if approved by the voters. Commissioner Teasley provided a second to the motion. The motion carried 4-0

d) Brown Plat Approval

Chairman Sayer moved to approve the Mr. Brown's plat to subdivide four lots off a large tract of property. Commissioner Bennett provided a second to the motion. The motion carried 3-1 (Commissioner Dorsey opposed due to shape of the proposed lots).

a) Setback Variance Request Bill Nix, Parcel C31 098

Commissioner Dorsey moved to approve 16' setback variance due to a hardship (power lines and location of septic tank). Chairman Sayer provided a second to the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

b) Amend Article VIII, Sec. 66-203. – Prohibition on through trucks, Exhibit A to add Joe Finley Road (District 5) (First Reading)

Chairman Sayer moved to accept the first reading to add Joe Finley Road for no through trucks list. Commissioner Bennett provided a second to the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

c) Request for Credit for experience EMS

Commissioner Dorsey moved to approve 2 years' credit for experience for John Moore (retro to March 1, 2023); 2 year's credit for Cameron Hughes and Christie Zolner. Commissioner Teasley provided a second to the motion. The motion carried 4-0.
