Hart County Board of Commissioners met September 27, 2022 at the Hart County Administrative & Emergency Services Center at 6:00 p.m.

Chairman Marshall Sayer presided with Commissioners Michael Bennett, Frankie Teasley, Jeff Brown and Joey Dorsey in attendance.

1. Prayer

Prayer was offered by Chairman Sayer.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

Everyone stood in observance of the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Call to Order

Chairman Sayer called the meeting to order.

4. Welcome

Chairman Sayer welcomed those in attendance.

5. Approve Agenda

Commissioner Teasley moved to amend and approve the agenda to include item 13 c) Request Bid Basketball Uniforms. Commissioner Bennett provided a second to the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

Commissioner Teasley moved to approve the minutes of September 13, 2022 regular meeting. Commissioner Brown provided a second to the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

Commissioner Bennett moved to approve the minutes of September 6, 2022 called meeting. Commissioner Brown provided a second to the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

7. Remarks By Invited Guests, Committees, Authorities UGA Archway Update Bill Leard

Chairman of Archway Program Bill Leard updated the BOC on the various projects that UGA students have been involved with over the past year; and thanked the BOC for their support.

8. Reports By Constitutional Officers & Department Heads

Attorney Kim Higginbotham reported the documentation for the jail project has been duly recorded in the Clerk of Court's office.

9. County Administrator's Report

County Administrator Terrell Partain reported there were seventeen local agencies involved with the recovery of the plane; 80 people involved; thanked all the local businesses that provided pontoons and meals during the search and recovery process; and the family met with the recovery team for lunch last week.

10. Chairman's Report

Chairman Sayer offered heartfelt sympathy to the family of the plane crash victim; thanked Administrator Partain and all those involved in the recovery efforts.

11. Commissioner's Reports

Commissioner Bennett thanked county employees for their efforts.

Commissioner Teasley thanked public safety employees; and reported he has received calls concerning county trash bags.

Commissioner Brown thanked volunteer fire fighters.

Commissioner Dorsey thanked Administrator Partain and Attorney Higginbotham for the jail project funding process; inquired about road stripping; requested a corrective action plan for issues at the Transfer Station and requested the SW Department Head to present the correction action plan at the next BOC meeting.

g) Amendment to Chapter 6, ARTICLE I, Sec. 6-64 (a) – Application to be made annually, Sec. 6-76 (a) (2) – Employee/server regulations, Sec. 6-84 (d) – Authority of county to levy tax (2nd Reading)

Commissioner Dorsey moved to approve the 2nd reading of Amendments to Chapter 6 Article I. Commissioner Teasley provided a second to the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

h) Emily Brown (Kings Bench Lots) appeal of 08/09/2022 denial to approve of five lots off Kings Bench

Chase Brown explained his father purchased Kings Bench property six years prior wasn't aware of the December 1, 2021 deadline for the subdivision moratorium.

Commissioner Dorsey moved to deny the appeal until the moratorium is lifted. Commissioner Brown provided a second to the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

i) Bid Opening for Tennis/Pickle Ball Lighting

Bids were received and opened from Cory Clark Electric (\$232,297) and Middle Ga. Outdoor Lighting (\$200,540).

Commissioner Dorsey moved to defer the bids to Administrator Partain and Rec Director Owens for review and recommendation. Commissioner Brown provided a second to the motion. The motion carried 5-0.
