Splotted money \$300,000 in 2011 and 1.4 million if the new splotted is voted in 2012.

Plan A is to replace 6 trucks and plan B is to build Reed Creek a new station.

Need appointments for the Fire Board for next year.

Went though application that has been collected this year.
