Hart County 911 is creating an Automated External Defibrillator registry in compliance with Georgia Senate bill 399, the Mason Sells AED Coordination Act. This registry will assist 911 Dispatchers to identify and direct callers to any nearby AED's during cardiac emergencies. If your business, church, school, gym, recreation facility, government building, or organization has an AED, Georgia law now requires that its location be reported to your local 911 Center.
